Charles Boulton & Emma Boulton Grantor of Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake, State of Utah, hereby license and permit the State Road Commission of Utah, Licensee, for the sum of Ninety-three Dollars DOLLARS to use the following described premises situated upon the grantor's land in the SW 1/4 of Section 3, T. 1 S., R. 1 W., S. 2. E.

in Salt Lake County, Utah, for the purpose of constructing thereon an irrigation ditch and appurtenant parts thereof:

A strip of land, 10 ft. wide, adjoining the north boundary line of said grantors land, the boundaries of said strip being described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of said north boundary line of the grantors land and the easterly right of way line of highway known as F. A. Project No. 229, which point is approximately 56 ft. east and approximately 717.1 ft. N. 0° 03' 08" W. along said easterly right of way line, from the south 1/2 corner of said Section 3; T. 1 S., R. 1 W., S. 2. E. thence east, 219.8 ft. along said north boundary line to the northeast corner of said grantors land; thence south 10 ft.; thence west 219.8 ft. parallel to said north boundary line; thence N. 0° 03' 08" W. 10 ft. along said easterly right of way line to the point of beginning, containing 0.07 acre.

After said ditch is constructed on above described premises at the expense of Licensee, said Licensee is thereafter relieved of any further claim or demand for costs, damages or maintenance charges which may accrue against said ditch or appurtenant parts thereof.
