FIRST SECURITY TRUST COMPANY, Salt Lake City, Utah, a Utah corporation doing business in the State of Utah, Grantor, hereby conveys, and warrants to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, inspection, relocation and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution, telephone and telegraph circuits of the Grantee, and six two pole towers and 20 guy anchors with the necessary guys, stubs, cross arms, braces and other attachments affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, on, under, over, through, and across a tract of land (50) feet in width, located in Salt Lake County, Utah, and being twenty-five (25) feet on each side of the following described center line:

Beginning at fence on north boundary line of grantor's land at a point 1325 feet west, more or less, from the east quarter corner of Section 31, T 3 S, R 1 W, SLD M, thence running S. 37° 27' E. 3372 feet to south boundary line of said land at north fence line of County Road and being in the E 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Section 31 and the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 32, Township and Range aforesaid.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
