WARRANTY DEED

JAMES A. SLATER and wife MARY E. SLATER,

hereby convey and warrant to

WEBER COUNTY,

Grantee

for the sum of

Five Hundred and fifty (\$550.00)

DOLLARS, the following described tract of land in

Weber County, State of Utah;

Beginning at Corner 1, a point on the common line between the land formerly owned by Thos. B. Wheelwright now owned by Weber County, and Jas. A. Slater, whence the corner of Sections 14, 15, 22 and 23, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Salt Lake Meridian, as reestablished about 20 years since by Washington Jenkins, a quarterzite 11"x8"x6" set underground 18" and marked 111 on the South and 11 on the East; bears approximately South 62° 0' West 823 feet distant; Thence S. 57° 47' 30 " E. approximately 970 feet distant, and at 100 feet from the center line as surveyed of the Weber River Channel change, to corner 2, a point in disputed territory as between James A. Slater and Peter F. and Esther C. McFarland.

Thence West approximately 825 feet distant along a line also in dispute as to its locus to corner 3, a point on the east side line of the Wheelwright land now owned by Weber County.

Thence North approximately 505 feet distant along the east side line of the Weber County (Wheelwright) land to the place of beginning.

Containing 4.76 acres more or less, 1.50 acres of which lies in disputed territory. (\$1.00 U. S. revenue stamp affixed and cancelled.)
