KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That whereas, the undersigned, HOME BUILDERS, INC., A Corporation of the State of Utah, is the owner of certain percel of real property, situate in the County of Salt Lake, State of Utah, and described as follows, to wit:

All of Lots 2 to 78, inclusive, Block 2 and Lot 1, Block 1, BONNEVILLE GARDEN, a Subdivision of all of Lots 6, 7, 8, 17, 18, 19, and part of Lot 20 Block 6, Five Acre Plat "C", Big Field Survey.

And whereas said HOME BUILDERS, INC.
ivided said land into building lots in a subdivision

has subdivided said land into building lots in a subdivision designated as BONNEVILLE GARDEN, and is filing and recording the plat thereof as required by law, and

Whereas, it is desired in connection with the platting and subdivision of said land and as part of a general building plan for the benefit and protection of the owners of the respective parcels, within said area to provide for certain use restrictions, which shall govern and control the use and enjoyment of the lots within such subdivision.

Now, therefore, the undersigned, HOME BUILDERS, INC., does hereby certify and declare that each and all of the lots within owners and the successive such subdivision shall be owned, held and enjoyed by the properties grantees thereof, their heirs and assigns subject to the following restrictions:

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(b)

All lots in the tract shall be known and described as recidential lots. No structures shall be erected, altered, placed, or permitted to mendin on any residential building plot other than one detached single-family dwelling not to exceed one story in height and a private garage for not more than two cars.

No building shall be crected, placed, or altered on any building plot in this subdivision until the building plans, specifications, and plot plan chowing the location of such building have been approved in writing as to conformity and harmony of external design with existing structures in the subdivision, and as to location of the building with respect to topography and finished ground elevation, by a committee composed of M.A. SNITH, J.K. THAYN, and CARL E. CHYTRAUS, or by a representative designated by a majority of the members of said committee. In the event of death of resignation of any member of said committee, the remaining member, or members, shall have full authority to approve or disapprove such design and location or to designate a representative with like authority. In the event said committee, or its designated representative fails to approve or disapprove such design and location within thirty days after said plans and specifications have been submitted to it or, in any event, if no su it to enjoin the erection of such building or the making of such alterations has been commenced prior to the completion thereof, such approval will not be required and this Covenant will be deemed to havebeen fully complied with. Meither the members of such committee, nor its designated representative shall be emitted to any compensation for services performed pursuant to this Covenant. The powers and duties of such committee and of its designated representative shall cease on and after January 1, 1950. Thereafter the approval described in this covenant shall not be required unless, prior to to said date and effective thereon, a written instrument shall be executed by the then record owners of a majority of the lots in this subdivid on and duly, recorded appointing a representative, or representatives, who shall thereafter exercise the same powers previously exercised by said committee.

An easement is reserved over the rear 5 feet of each lot for utility installation and maintenance. No building shall be located on any residential building shall be located on any residential building plot nearer than 22 feet to the front lot line, nor nearer than 25 feet to any side street line except on 23rd East street improvements may be located 22 feet from front lot line and 13feet from side street line. No building except a detached garage or other outbuilding located sixty (60) feet or more from thefront lot line, shall be located nearer than eight (8) feet to any side lot line.

No residential structure shall be erected or placed on any building plot, which plot has an area of less than 6000 square feet, or a width of less than fifty-mix (56) feet at the front building setback line.

No noxious or offensive trade or activity shall be carried on upon any lot nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood.

No trailer, basement, tent, shack, garage, barn, or other outbuilding erected in the tract shall at any time be used as a residence temporarily or permanently, nor shall any structure of a temporary character be used as a residence.

(g)

No dwelling costing less than \$4500.00 shall be permitted on any lot in the tract. The ground floor area of the main structure, exclusive of one-story open porches and garages, shall be not less than 800 square feet.

(h)

No persons of any race other than the Caucasian race shall use or occupy any building or any lot, except that this covenant shall not prevent occupancy by domestic servants of a different race domiciled with an owner or tenant.

These covenants are to run with the land and shall be binding on all parties and all persons claiming under them until Jamary 1, 1970, at which time said covenants mall be automatically extended for successive periods of ten years unless by vote of a majority of the then owners of the lots it is agreed to change said covenants in whole or in part.

If the parties hereto, or any of them or their heirs or assigns, shall violate or attempt to violate any of the covenants herein, it shall be lawful for any other person or persons owning any real property situated in said development or subdivision to prosecute any proceedings at law or in equity against the person or persons violating or attempting to violate any such covenant and either to prevent him or them from so doing or to recover damages or other dues for such violation.

Invalidation of any one of these covenants by judgment or court order shall in no wise affect any of the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.
