ORDINANCE NO. 222

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND SETTING ASIDE CERTAIN STREETS AND ALLEY WAYS IN THE OAK DELL ADDITION TO PROVO CITY, UTAH,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF PROVO CITY,

UTAH:

SECTION I:

WHEREAS, on the 29th day of October, 1889, Joab Collier, Theodosia Collier and Don R. Coray, the then owners of certain real property did by recordation of certain plat with the Office of the Utah County Recorder establish a certain subdivision known as Oakdell Addition to Provo City, Utah, and by which recordation on the 29th of October, 1889, certain streets and alleys were dedicated for the public use and,

WHEREAS, subsequent to the above conveyance the City Engineer, the City Traffic Engineer, and the Board of Commissioners of Provo City are satisfied that the following portions of said subdivision serve no useful purpose and are inconsistent with modern planning and road requirements, and

WHEREAS, the present owners of the property, to-wit: R. J. Walker, LeRoy F. Dyson, E. Gene Dyson, Gary E. Anderson, Marilyn Anderson, Blaine L. Anderson, David S. Grow Jr., Edward W. Clyde and William T. Thurman, Administrator of the Estate of Samuel R.

Thurman, deceased, have prepared under the direction and with the approval of the Administration and necessary Boards of the City a subdivision known as Oak Cliff Planned Dwelling Group together with other uses inconsistent with the original Oakdell Addition and have petitioned that all streets within the following described property be vacated and it has been determined by the City Commission that it is in the best interest of the residents of Provo City that the same be vacated and set aside and reconveyed by the City to the successors and interest of the original grantors the said property within which streets are to be vacated being located within the following described property in Utah County, State of Utah, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 32, Township 6 South, Range 3 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian; thence North 1666.5 feet; thence East 330.0 feet; thence South 346.5 feet; thence East 385.04 feet; thence South 14° 45' East 414.51 feet; thence South 12° 20' East 300.0 feet; thence South 17° 20' East 353.0 feet; thence South 288.21 feet, more or less, to the South line of said Section 32; thence West along the said Section line 989.9 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

Reserving to the public any existing utility easements or rights-of-way including pipelines and irrigation facilities which are apparent on the grounds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of Provo City, hereby ordain that all streets, alleys and public ways within the above description, which constitute a portion only of Oakdell Addition to Provo City, be and same are hereby vacated, set aside in favor of the adjoining property owners.

SECTION II:

It is in the opinion of the Board of Commissioners of

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Provo City necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of Provo City, that this Ordinance take effect immediately, therefore this Ordinance shall take effect upon its date of first publication.
