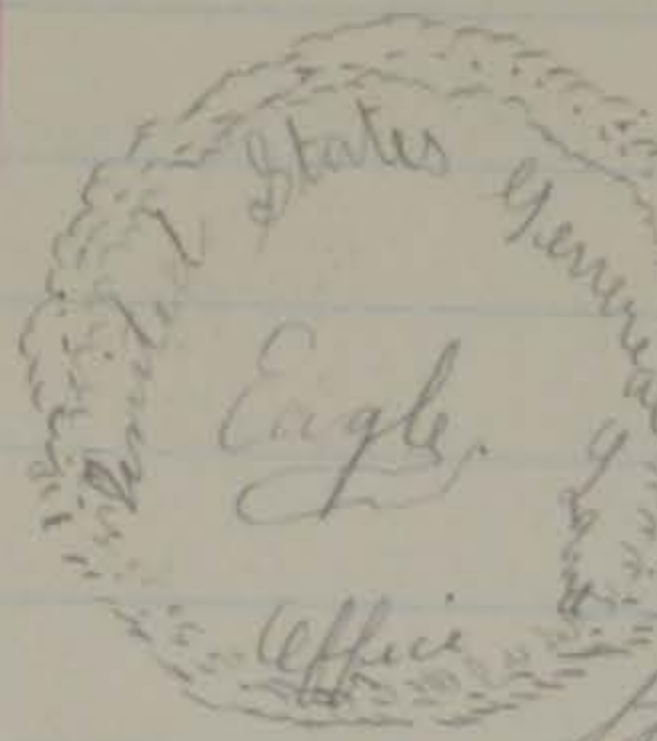


@ The United States Of America.
 To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting.
 Homestead Certificate No. 4649.
 Application 7249.

Whereas There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States of Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City, Utah Territory, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers in the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Joseph H. Pollock has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the North half of the South East quarter; the North East quarter of the South West quarter, and the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section nine, in Township thirty eight South of Range eleven West of Salt Lake Meridian in Utah Territory containing one hundred and sixty Acres. According to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now know ye, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Joseph H. Pollock, the tract of land above described; To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Joseph H. Pollock and to his heirs and assigns forever: subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove the ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.

 Thirty-eight, 38, South of Range Eleven $\frac{1}{2}$, West Salt
 Lake Meridian, Utah Territory, Containing One Hundred
 and Sixty $\frac{1}{2}$ Acres.
