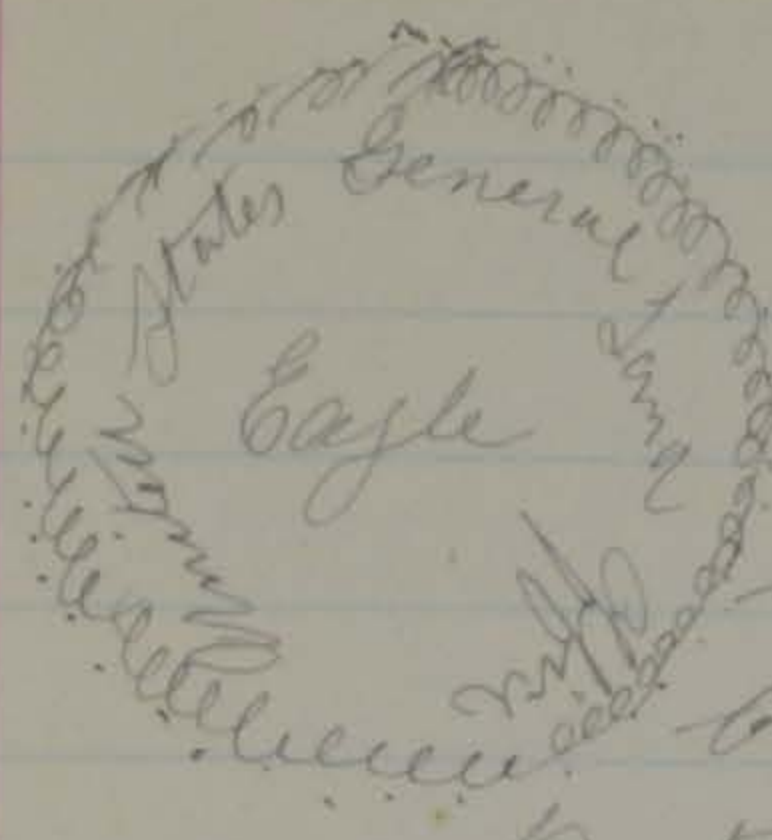


The United States of America

To all to whom these Presents shall come Grating;
Whereas, In pursuance ^{of the Revised Statutes} of the United States, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States the certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City in the Territory of Utah, whereby it appears that ^{Charles D. Moore} did on the eighteenth day of August, A.D. 1890, enter and pay for the south half of the north east quarter; the north west quarter of the south east quarter and the north east quarter of the south west quarter, of section eight, in township thirty eight south of range eleven west, Salt Lake Meridian, embracing one hundred and sixty acres of land, more or less, as shown by the Official plat of the survey of said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, The same being coal entry No. 90 in series of said Office.

Now Know All, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with said Act of Congress, have given, and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Charles D. Moore and to his heirs the said tracts above described: To have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Charles D. Moore, and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water right for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove the ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States. In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

have given and granted, and by these presents,
do give and grant, unto the said, Charles
T. Tiernan and to his heirs the said tracts
above described: To have and to hold the same
together with all the rights, privileges, immunities,
and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto
belonging, unto the said Charles T. Tiernan
and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to
