Whereas Lee Bybee of Weber County, Utah Territory, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office, at Salt Lake City, Utah Territory, whereby it appears that Full Payment has been made by the said Lee Bybee, according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provisions for the sale of the public lands, for the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section twelve, the East ^{North East Quarter, and the} North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section thirteen, in Township five North of Range two West in the district of lands subject to sale at Salt Lake City, Utah Territory, containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tracts have been purchased by the said Lee Bybee.

Now Know Ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, Have given and Granted and by these presents Do Give and Grant unto the said Lee Bybee and to his heirs the said Tract above described, To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the right, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Lee Bybee and to his heirs and assigns forever.

United States In Testimony whereof, I, Wm. S. Grant President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
