

widen a State Highway adjacent to the south boundary of the said Naval Supply Depot; and,

WHEREAS, the Government, pursuant to the authority contained in the aforesaid "Second War Powers Act, 1942", is willing to grant to the State of Utah, an easement for the construction, maintenance, and operation of an addition to said highway upon a portion of Government property hereinafter described and acquired as aforesaid at the location shown in red on the attached photostat of drawing consisting of six (6) sheets, bearing legend "Drawing No. A-312 (6 sheets) Easements to State of Utah for widening of Access Road to U.S. Naval Supply Depot, Clearfield, Davis County, Utah."

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the Government, pursuant to the authority of the aforesaid Act of Congress, hereby grants and conveys to The State of Utah, a perpetual right-of-way and easement, for highway purposes, upon and over a strip of land comprising a portion of the Naval Supply Depot, situated in Section 12, Township 4 North, Range 2 West, S.L.M., County of Davis, State of Utah, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 33 ft. north and 3545.24 feet. S. 89° 51' E., from the southwest corner of Section 12, T. 4 N., R. 2 W., S.L.M., which point is on the westerly boundary line of the D. & R. G. W. Railroad right of way; thence N. 89° 51' W., 3545.24 feet; thence N. 89° 59' W., 3820.45 feet; thence N. 0° 10' E., 30.8 ft. to a point 60 feet north from the center line of survey of highway known as F.A.S. Project No. 15-A; thence N. 89° 45' E., 1808.7 feet; thence S. 89° 53' E., 5425.1 feet; thence N. 89° 53' E., 109.7 feet, to said westerly boundary line of the D. & R. G. W. Railroad; thence S. 34° 40' E., 38.9 feet to the point of beginning, containing 5.25 acres.

together with the right, privilege and authority to do such other things thereon as necessarily appertain to the occupancy and enjoyment of said easement and the exercise of the rights herein granted.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said right-of-way and easement unto The State of Utah, its successors and assigns; subject however, to the condition that in the event the land above described shall be abandoned or used for any purpose or purposes other than that for which this grant is made, or shall cease to be maintained by the Grantee for the purposes for which granted, such land shall thereupon revert to the United States of America.
