

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Homestead Certificate No. 3514

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City Utah Territory, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved May 20th 1862, "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the Acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Henny Gloyd has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the north half of the south west quarter of section two in township five north of range two west of Salt Lake Meridian in Utah Territory containing eighty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General;

Now know all, that there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Henny Gloyd the tract of Land above described:

To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances hereof, unto the said Henny Gloyd and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to

any valid and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to disclose and reservoirs need in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.

Ed testimony whereof I Grover Cleveland, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the twenty eighth day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty eight, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and twelfth.

This Indenture, Made the twenty-second day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty eight, between Francis M. Preece, and Lizzie Preece, his wife of Wenatch, in the Territory of Idaho, and George Preece and Jane W. Preece, his wife of Lynn in the County of Nebo and Territory of Utah, parties of the first part, and Adair H. Chamberlain, of Logden City, in the County of Nebo and Territory of Utah, the party of the second part, Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Four thousand and seventy-five Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, remised, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, remise, release convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns for ever, that certain piece or parcel of land, situated in the County of Nebo and Territory of Utah, bounded and described as follows to wit:

The North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section Thirty five (35), in Township Six (6) North of Range two (2) West of the Salt Lake Meridian, W. L. Survey, containing Forty Acres of land, more or less.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto
