1. John Dawson and Fannie Dawson his wife, Grantors of Weber County, Utah, hereby convey and warrant to UTAH POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 1 guy anchor 3 ~~xxxxxxx~~ poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, crossarms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits; to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantors, in Weber County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beginning on north boundary line of Grantor's land at south fence line of County road at a point 1320 feet north and 1320 feet west, more or less, from the southeast corner of Section 1, T. 5 N., R. 2W, S.L.B.&M., thence running S. 61°03' E. 1331 feet, more or less, on said land and being in the SE 1/4 of the

occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation, or enjoyment of this easement.

CONDUIT EASEMENT

Oetta Browning Glascock, ~~and~~ her separate property ~~interests~~, Grantors, of Ogden City, Weber County Utah, hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and quitclaim to UTAH LIGHT AND TRACTION COMPANY, a corporation Grantee, for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration an easement and right of way for the construction and continued maintenance, operation, alteration, repair and replacement of a single two and one-half inch galvanized iron conduit containing one three-conductor No. 4 5,000 volt lead covered cable and one No. 4 bare copper neutral. Said conduit to be placed eighteen inches below the ground a long a center line described as follows:

Beginning on the east line of Lot 22 of Block 1, Dundee Place Subdivision in Block 11, Plat "C", Ogden City Survey; thence running 18 inches south of north line of said lot 22 137 feet to west line of said lot 22 including all necessary equipment incident thereto.

Together with all rights of ingress or egress necessary or convenient for the full use and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, provided that Grantee, its successors in interest and assigns, in doing a work of construction, maintenance, alteration or repair of said conduit, shall do so in a good and workman like manner.

Grantee shall at all times indemnify, save harmless and defend Grantors against any and all claims causes of action, loss, damage or expense arising out of the use or enjoyment by Grantee of this easement and the operation or use of said conduit.
